PRO TIPS ARE FROM THE WHITE TEES

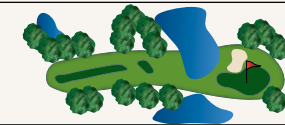

Aim left of center in the fairway. This allows you a better angle to this long par five. Laying up to 120 yards is the best play if you can't reach the green in two.

If you are between clubs, take the longer of the two. The ball checks back quite a bit on this sloping green.



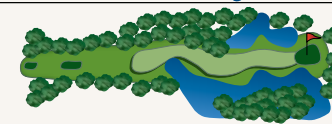

Safest play is to aim between the 150 and 100 yard markers. This leaves a short iron to a slightly elevated green.



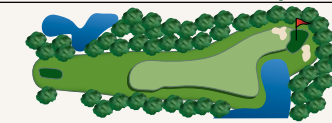

Not very long but extremely dangerous! Must be straight and below this pin to make birdie or par.



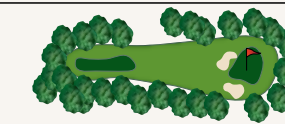

Aim left of center off the tee. 220 yard drive leaves the best approach to this hillside green.



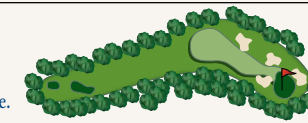

Can't see the green so trust the distance. Follow the yardage markers but do not be long!



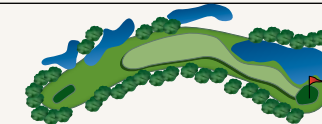

200 yard shot down the middle from this elevated tee is the safe approach to this dogleg right with an elevated green. Big hitters can cut the corner and go for eagle.



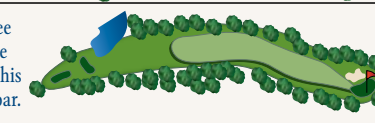

240 yard shot from the sign takes you to the edge of the water on this slight dogleg. Keep your approach shot right or get wet.



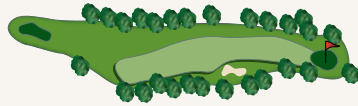

This hole favors a left to right tee shot. Take at least one club more when hitting your approach to this elevated green. Be happy with par.



PRO TIPS ARE FROM THE WHITE TEES

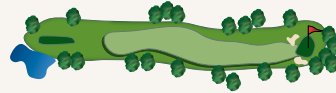
1 Keep your drive left of the fairway bunker for a clear shot to the green.



2 Check the wind here. Take an extra club to be long, as most balls spin back toward the water.



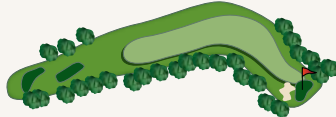
3 Straight down the middle rewards you with a short iron to this elevated green.



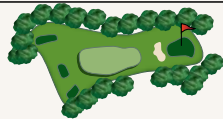
4 Aim your tee shot left-center of the fairway. Left on your approach is the best miss, as there is a water hazard to the right of the green.



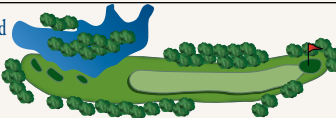
5 215 yard drive will leave you 100 yards away to elevated green.



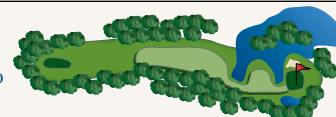
6 Don't club down too much because of elevated tee. Imperative to be below the hole on this large sloping green.



7 Let it fly down the middle to this elevated landing area. Second shot may be a club less than yardage. This green allows you to get close, so go for the pin.



8 Blind tee shot is 235 yards to water from sign. Your 200 yard club leaves you a short iron, slight downhill lie into the green.



9 Cutting the corner takes a real bomb. Straight 2nd shot keeps you out of the fairway bunkers for a short iron approach to this green surrounded by bunkers.



USGA RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY UNLESS MODIFIED BY LOCAL RULES. PLEASE...

- Replace divots, fix ball marks and rake bunkers.
- Play ready golf and maintain pace of play. No more than 5 minutes is allowed at the turn. Kindly let faster players play through.
- Exercise caution and keep carts 30 feet from tees and greens or on paths provided at all times.
- Consider etiquette as binding as the rules.
- 100, 150, 200 yardage disks are to the center of the green.
- MI Law: Alcohol on course must be purchased on site.

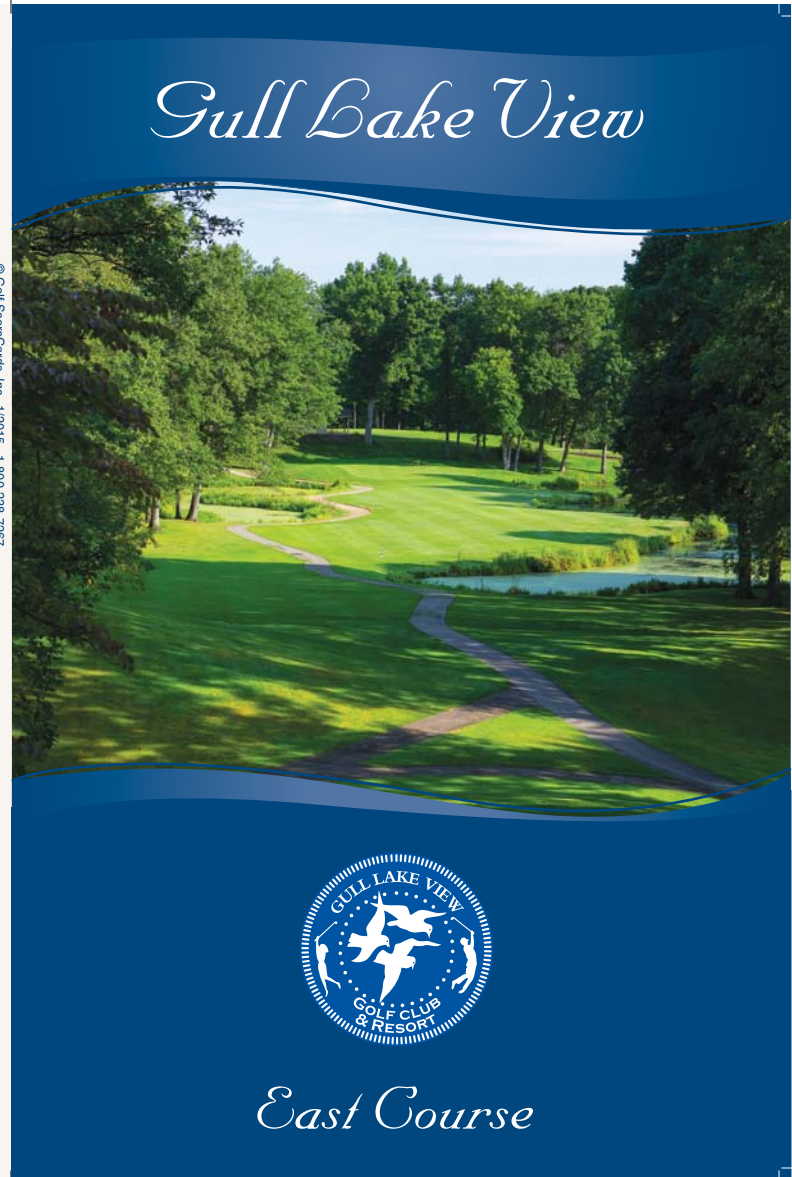
